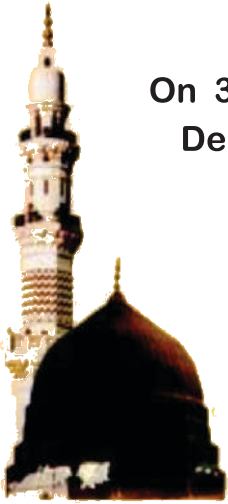

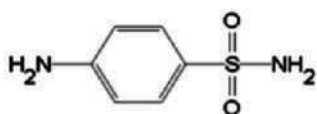

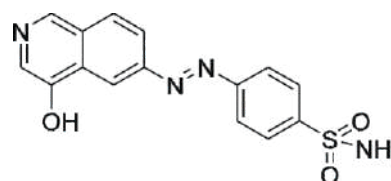
Enhancement of Antibacterial Activity

Sulfanilamide is an aromatic compound and for many decades it has been used as antibacterial agent. The given research is all about enhancement of antibacterial activity of sulfanilamide. The sulfanilamide was modified to azo moiety by a method called azo coupling. In this method first the diazonium salt was prepared by reacting sulfanilamide and sodium nitrite in acidic medium. The diazonium salt was then coupled with 8-hydroxyquinoline in aqueous alkaline medium. The coupling results in the formation of azo dye. The followed experimental procedure was simple and had a high reaction rate and excellent yield. The synthesized compound was characterized by using UV-Visible and IR spectrophotometer. The antibacterial activities of the synthesized compound was evaluated against Gram positive (*Staphylococci*) and Gram negative (*Escherichia coli*) microorganisms through disk diffusion method. The azo compound formed of sulfanilamide has shown better activity against *Staphylococci* and *Escherichia coli* than the parent compound.

How many more alarms do we need?! People of my country! Wakeup! Get up and do something! Take a step. Make an effort no matter how small.

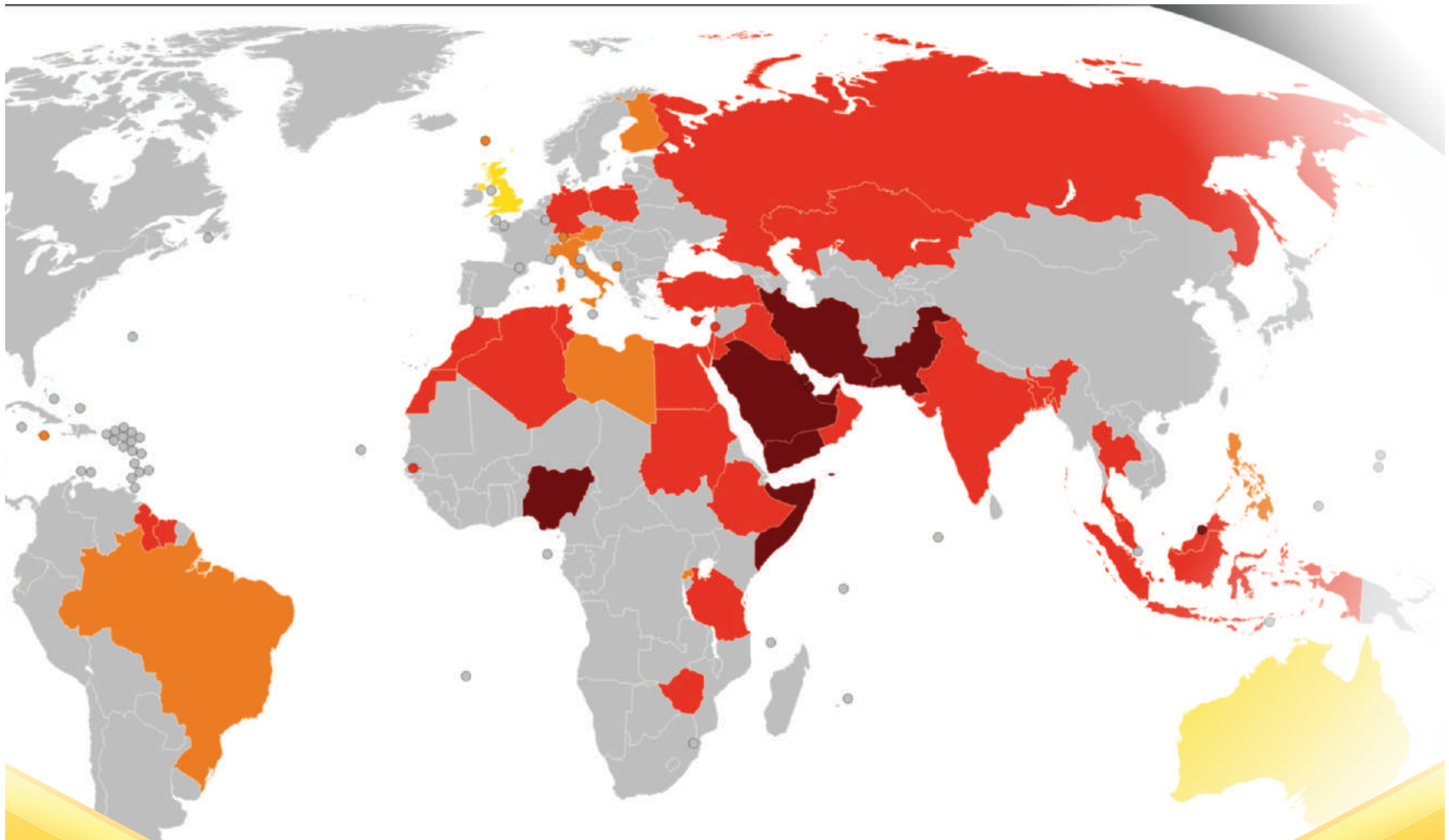

1st) SAUDI ARABIA:

When going out, women are not allowed to wear casual clothes, and they should only be with a relative if it's a man. The outlets of their media are closely monitored, and the access to their internet is limited. Sabir suggests that Rahman had a Naqshbandi Sufi tariqa initiation in Kohat, as well as training from the sons of Pir Baba. Schimmel and Saad Ahmed Baksh casually assign Rahman to the Chishti order. Aqab, himself of the Qadiriyyah order, claims Rahman was a Qadiri.

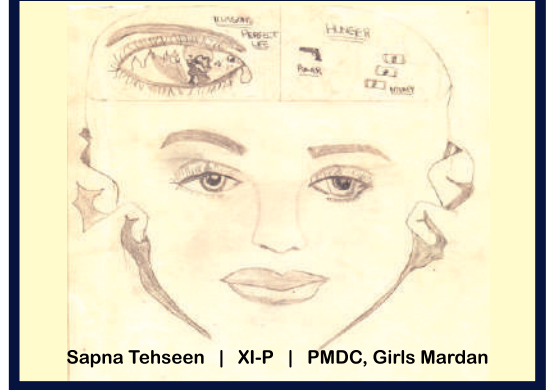
